To keep everyone as safe as possible, we ask that you join us in following these CDC-recommended practices for in person worship.

- We will continue to worship in the Olyn Houser Worship Activity Center, which is located at the back of the campus. Please observe the Entrance and Exit signs, as both Entrance and Exit will be one way. Ushers will be present to greet and direct you.
- 2. We encourage those who are medically vulnerable to continue worshiping with us online.
- 3. All who attend **must wear a face mask** and **maintain social distancing**. Please continue to worship online if you prefer to not wear a face covering.
- 4. Please seat your family three to six feet apart (in all directions) from other families. Seating has been set up to provide spaced physical distancing.
- 5. Bibles, hymnals and worship materials have been removed from the sanctuary for your added safety. All worship information will be on the screen. Please bring pen and paper for any notes you may want to capture.

- 8. Small church groups (including Sunday School classes) and committees will continue to meet via Zoom or off campus.
